

IEA SCORE Rubric for Project Proposals

Completed applications are evaluated based on the criteria below. Points allotted align with descriptors to the right.

I. Significance of the project to impact community

- Evidence demonstrates the project's potential to make a significant contribution; community partner has been contacted ahead of time about possibility of working together/already worked together in past
- <u>1</u> Evidence demonstrates the project's potential to make a contribution
- Unclear how the project will impact the community

II. Data shared about needs of the school and/or community that will be met as a result of the project

- Data provided as evidence to demonstrate a clear description of the needs that will be met
- <u>1</u> Evidence includes little description of the needs
- O No data provided as evidence of what needs are trying to be met

III. Projected involvement of others

- <u>2</u> Evidence demonstrates the project's potential to involve 5 or more colleagues and others as additional volunteers (parents, other educators, community members)
- <u>1</u> Evidence demonstrates the project's potential to involve very few other adult volunteers and/or only students
- O Involvement is limited to only the applicant and his/her students

IV. Communication about the project goals and implementation

- Evidence of a plan to communicate about the project using social media; such as accounts already established and website links provided
- <u>1</u> Plan to communicate is not well thought out; willing to promote on social media but no examples provided
- No communication plan in application about how the project will be featured on social media

V. Directions/Support

- <u>4</u> Unique idea proposed, responded to all areas of application without errors, included a letter of support from additional volunteers and/or identified community partner
- Responded to all areas of application with few if any errors, included a letter of support from additional volunteers and/or identified community partner
- <u>2</u> Responded to all areas of application with few if any errors
- Application responses may be incomplete or not well thought out; community component or volunteering is absent
