# Illinoisans feel very strongly about giving students access to books in schools.

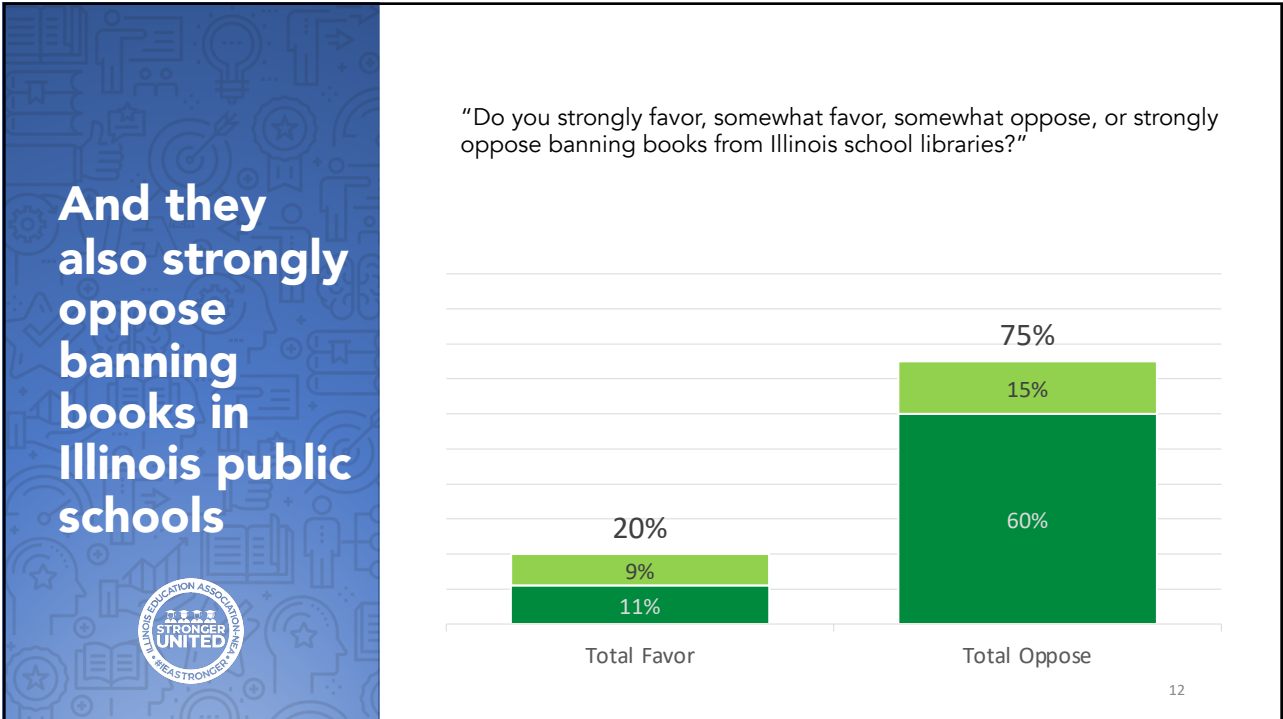
