Unsure of how to get started with the registration process?

1st: Complete Educators Rising memberships if you haven't already. Then email us at educatorsrising@ieanea.org with a list of your students' names who have EdRising memberships. If you have an invoice from EdRising national, you can email that instead or in addition to your list. After that confirmation, you'll obtain the promo code to receive a discount for students' registrations.

2nd: Complete your conference event registrations.

3rd: If you plan to have students compete, register them for the competition as soon as possible using the link in the purple box on the event site.


** Educators Rising Illinois "Help Desk" **
